

Descendants of Frederick William Hackett

Generation No. 1

1. FREDERICK WILLIAM¹ HACKETT^{1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12} was born December 28, 1820 in Ireland (possibly Birr, County Offaly)¹³, and died July 25, 1890 in Brooklyn, NY¹³. He married JULIA EMMA HOOPER^{14,15,16,17,18,19} May 14, 1853 in Port Hope, Ontario, Canada, St Johns-C of E²⁰. She was born April 1829 in London, Eng., and died March 28, 1903 in Rutherford, Bergen Co., NJ.

Notes for FREDERICK WILLIAM HACKETT:

Reportedly (wedding announcement) had lived in Toronto prior to marriage. Owned shipping business at Port Hope on Lake Ontario-maintained a wharf and sold steamer tickets. Info from Port Hope, Ontario newspapers and 1861 Canadian Census. Port Hope now in Northumberland Co., Ontario. Was Durham Co. when Frederick lived there. Not found in 1871 Canada Census.

Residency in Toronto mentioned in Port Hope Newspaper Marriage announcement. His Toronto residence is buttressed by an item in a Toronto Directory of 1850 found on a Canadian Records CD at Prince William Library, Manassas, VA.. Marriage and some birth info from records of St. Johns Anglican Church in Port Hope.

Witnesses to his marriage were Jacob Fonke, Amelia Hackett (sister) and William Creelman. Marriage was by "license" per St. John's Church records.

!Other info: Last recorded date in Port Hope was 1865 at time of son James's birth. Records of St. Johns Ch.. 1861 Census shows an Amelia Hackett, possible sister age 22, b. Ireland, living with Frederick's family. He owned a shop/residence on Mill St., Port Hope on 1/4 acre lot. (1861 Canada Census)

!Immigration: Ireland to Canada by an unknown route and ship probably after 1839 based on his sister? (or other relative, ie niece or cousin) being born in Ireland in 1839.

Brooklyn address in 1880 looks like 4 Tillary St in census but hard to read hand writing.

Greenwood cemetery visited in April, 1999 and his plot was visited. No monuments were found for any Hacketts buried there but there were a couple of monuments for "Hooper" graves. Burial costs in or around 1890 were \$5.

Buried in lot # 16987, Section 189.

Wife Julia was listed as a widow in 1900 US Census for Rutherford, Bergen Co., NJ

She died in Rutherford but was buried in Brooklyn, NY with her late husband.

Notes for JULIA EMMA HOOPER:

Wedding announcement in "The Guide", Port Hope newspaper. Second daughter of William Hooper of Port Hope. Listed in church records as a Toronto resident at time of the wedding. Married by Rev. Jonathon Shortt at St. Johns (Church of Canada), Port Hope. The original building stands (1985) and is now named St. Mark's Anglican Church. The 1900 US Census for Rutherford, Bergen County, NJ enumerated Julia E. Hackett, age 71, living at 83 Woodward Ave in Rutherford with a daughter Julia E. (Scriven) and 2 grandchildren. Cemetery records for Julia Emma Hooper indicate England as her birthplace but the 1880 Census for Kings Co., NY gives Canada as her birthplace. The 1870 US Census gives England as her birthplace.

She owned the 82 Woodward Ave house in Rutherford and had a mortgage on it. Census reported she immigrated to the US in 1860 but show her giving birth to a child in Port Hope in 1865. (1880 US Census-Kings Co., NY.)

Both her parents were born in England per the 1861 Canadian Census. In 1900 in New Jersey she was reported to have been the mother of 7 children with 5 still living. Their existence known from 1900 NJ, Bergen County, Rutherford census data and the 1880 Census for Kings Co., Brooklyn. Clergyman at her funeral was Henry U. Ladd in Rutherford.

!Other info: One Wm Hooper married Mary Ann Grimes, both of Port Hope, Ont, Canada on June 1, 1852 at St. John's Ch. in the presence of John and Ann Wallis. They had a son, John James, b. 2 Mar 1853. Wm was possibly a brother of Julia.

Greenwood Cemetery visit made on April 17, 1999 and the lot 16987 was check out. No monuments were seen for any Hacketts (Frederick, Julia (nee Hooper), James) buried there. Stones for only two (of 4) Hoopers buried there were found.

Reportedly paid \$2000 to have Hackett Place paved. Built large home at corner of Hackett Pl and Union Ave.. He remarried and lived out his last years (30+) in or around Selma, Alabama. Reason for relocation unknown. Possibly his 2nd wife was from that area. His obit reported his move to Selma around 1913.
